


1.D. Expirations – Transfers between departments.

Normally it is not of much use although it may seem strange, since the food is bought to be consumed, and in the case that it is not consumed, it is lost.

However, there are certain articles that can be interesting to control their expiration date, such as Minibars in High Standing Hotels that, due to their customer profile, work with HIGH VALUE food, such as Swiss Cheeses, Belgian Chocolates, ..., and with certain expiration dates.

It is assumed that the Merchandise has previously entered a general Warehouse and is transferred to the different warehouses. At this moment is when we are asked for the EXPIRY DATE and the "LOT".






1.E. Expirations – Consumption by Department.

We locate the LOTS that we have and we give the CONSUMPTION.

It is obligatory for those products that treat CADUCITIES, to give the cancellations (consumptions), in this section, if they are wanted to control.
